Setup if another ext4mage modul installed though magento connect

If using magentocommerce.com/magento-connect/ when installing the module and you already have an ext4mage module installed you will get an error.

What you can do is the following:

1. delete folder `app/code/community/ext4mage/shared`
2. delete file `app/etc/modules/ext4mage_shared.xml`
3. set html2pdf active to false in `app/etc/modules/ext4mage_html2pdf.xml`
4. install orders2csv from magento
5. set html2pdf active to true in `app/etc/modules/ext4mage_html2pdf.xml`
6. delete all in `var/cache`

Manual setup also working for customers with another ext4mage module

On ext4mage.com you can download a zip packed with all the files of this module, just add the module to your basket and go through checkout, it is still free. When you are finished you can download the zip file under your account->my downloads.


In the zip file is to folders, step 1 and step 2. Start by coping all files and folders in step 1 into your installation, alternative overwriting existing ext4mage files. Then copy over all files in step 2 and your done – just remember to flush cache, see below – enjoy 😊

Backup Your Data

Backup your store database and web directory.

System setup options

Login into your Magento admin and go to *System-> Cache Management* and flush Magento Cache and refresh all cache types
